## Future-focused governance structure for Victorian Tertiary Admissions Centre (VTAC)

VTAC is transitioning to modern governance arrangements by dissolving its previous unincorporated entity and establishing a company limited by guarantee as of 1 July 2023. This change, endorsed by the Victorian Vice-Chancellors' Committee, will provide a leaner and more effective governance structure to enable VTAC to continue the delivery of high-quality admissions services to the Victorian community in years to come.

Improving our governance is a key enabling objective of VTAC's 2022-2023 strategic plan, supporting us to deliver on our mission of creating and delivering value for learners, providers, and people.

The inaugural chair of the VTAC Board will be Professor Iain Martin, Vice-Chancellor of Deakin University and current chair of the Victorian Vice-Chancellors' Committee. The inaugural VTAC CEO Teresa Tjia, appointed in 2022, will continue to lead the company.

VTAC remains a sector-led shared service organisation for learners, schools, and tertiary institutions. There will be no interruption of service to our stakeholders as a result of this change. The new governance structure will support VTAC's vision to empower, connect, and support learners and providers to enable transparent and inclusive access to education.
