



VTAC statement on 2024 VCE results and ATAR calculation

From a VTAC spokesperson:

For many Victorian students, the release of their ATAR is a milestone moment signifying the end of their secondary schooling and in taking the next steps in their educational and career journey.

VTAC, which is independent of the VCAA, calculates the Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) for Victorian students every year on the basis of the VCE study scores provided by the VCAA. Over the past month VTAC has worked closely with the VCAA to ensure the timely release of the ATAR, enabling tertiary offers for year 12 students.

VTAC's expert Scaling Committee, which oversees the ATAR calculation, has liaised closely with the VCAA. They have been assured of the approaches taken by the VCAA in verifying the quality of the 2024 assessment data and the calculation of the study scores that have been provided to VTAC.

The Scaling Committee has reviewed the outputs of the VTAC scaling process for each VCE study and agreed to proceed with ATAR calculations. Based on the assurances from VCAA, the VTAC Scaling Committee is of the view that the 2024 ATAR calculations are valid.

VCE results and ATAR will be released to students at 7am, Thursday 12 December 2024 via resultsandatar.vic.edu.au. This will be followed by VTAC's release of first round tertiary course offers on 23 December 2024, and further offer rounds in January and February 2025.
