## V-News RSS feed

Course updates, amendments and other information will now be available as an RSS feed on the VTAC website. An RSS (Really Simple Syndication) feed allows interested readers to subscribe to frequently updated notifications without having to check a website or subscribe to an email newsletter.

The RSS system will replace the V-News e-mail newsletter service. Electronic versions of the VTAC Bulletin will continue to be produced, and their publication will be included on the RSS feed.

There are many ways to subscribe to an RSS feed: they can be accessed via dedicated feed reader software or mobile device apps, e-mail programs, web browsers, or online services such as Google Reader. Instructions for some common software are detailed below, but should be similar for other software.

### Subscribing in email software

#### Microsoft Outlook

1. On the Tools menu, click Account Settings.
2. On the RSS Feeds tab, click New.
3. In the New RSS Feed dialog box, type or press CTRL+V to paste the URL of the RSS Feed: <http://www.vtac.edu.au/vnews/vnews.xml>
4. Click Add.
5. Click OK.

### Apple Mail

1. Choose File > Add RSS Feeds, or click the Add (+) button at the bottom of the sidebar, and then choose Add RSS Feeds.
2. Browse and select the feed if you've bookmarked it in Safari, or enter or paste the URL: <http://www.vtac.edu.au/vnews/vnews.xml>
3. To include RSS feeds in your Inbox, click Show in Inbox.
4. Click Add.

### Subscribing in a web browser

1. Enter or paste the URL <http://www.vtac.edu.au/vnews/vnews.xml> into the browser's address bar. Most browsers will allow you to save the feed as a bookmark or favourite, or to display the feed headlines in a dynamic menu.

### Subscribing on a web-based reader

#### Google Reader

1. Log in to iGoogle using your Google account
2. Click on Reader to enter the Google Reader application
3. Press the Add a subscription button and enter or paste the URL: <http://www.vtac.edu.au/vnews/vnews.xml>
4. Several mobile apps can sync with your Google Reader subscriptions if you wish to receive updates on your mobile device.
