What is the ATAR?

The Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) is an overall measure of how well a student has performed in your VCE studies. It is created by the Victorian Tertiary Admissions Centre (VTAC) on behalf of institutions to assist in tertiary selection.

Who will get an ATAR?

All students who have satisfied the requirements for the VCE and have study scores for one of (English, ESL, English Language and Literature) and at least three other studies (in a permissible combination) will be eligible to receive an ATAR.

Who will get an ATAR statement?

An ATAR statement will be issued to applicants who have paid all processing fees, have been awarded the VCE for the first time and have a minimum of four VCAA study scores (including a score for an English study) which are not subject to any restrictions or forbidden combinations.

Students who have previously obtained an ENTER, but have undertaken further study this year, resulting in an additional study score or increment(s) will have their ATAR recalculated. The higher of the two will be recorded and reported as an ATAR.

Accessing the ATAR

To access the ATAR students have three options:

- submit an SMS request to 19 787 888 (call cost \$1.10 incl. GST (max) per registration)
- log onto the Internet at resultsandatar.vic.edu.au
- telephone 1900 957 888 at \$1.93 per minute inc. GST (higher for mobile phones)

To access the ATAR students will also need their VCE student number and VTAC PIN.

Alternatively, that ATAR statement arrives in the mail either on Tuesday or Wednesday.
