



Prerequisite update for VTAC Guide 2009

In line with Victorian Institute of Teaching (VIT) requirements, the following Monash University undergraduate primary and secondary education programs and early childhood education programs have changed the mathematics prerequisites for undergraduate education courses:

To:

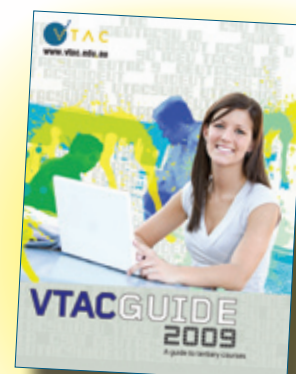
'Units 1 to 4—any two units from further mathematics, general mathematics, specialist mathematics or mathematical methods (either)'.
