VTAC has contacted the National Privacy Hotline and have been advised that we do not need to obtain individual student permission to send their data to schools. VTAC will be writing to all schools and notifying students of the details pertaining to the type of information it holds, who the information will be distributed to and the reasons for distribution.

Therefore if a student wants to withhold data from schools they must advise VTAC in writing. VTAC will be distributing its 'guidelines for the distribution of student data to schools' in late July early August. Schools must agree to these guidelines before data is distributed.

#### Repeat Penalty

VTAC wishes to advise schools and students that the repeat penalty of 10% on repeated studies will be removed retrospectively from 1 January 2003.
