VET Fee HELP

VET FEE-HELP is an Australian Government loan scheme for the Vocational Education and Training (VET) sector that is part of the Higher Education Loan Program (HELP). Students studying at the diploma and above level may be able to apply through their training provider for VET FEE-HELP assistance to defer the cost of their studies.

VET FEE-HELP is currently available for full fee-paying (fee-for-service) students undertaking certain studies in the VET sector. However from 1 July 2009, students whose enrolments are Victorian Government funded may also be able to access VET FEE-HELP assistance. HECS HELP

The Commonwealth Government offers a loan scheme called HECS-HELP that allows students to defer the payment of their contribution and repay it later through the taxation system. Students who choose the deferred option are not required to begin re-paying their debt until their income reaches the minimum threshold, which is \$41,595 in the 2008-09 financial year. Institutions to which you have applied must display on their websites the student contribution amount for all units of study they propose to offer in the following half year. This information is updated on 1 October and 1 April each year.
