VTAC Policy on prerequisite studies

Applicants who are required to satisfy Year 12 subject prerequisites or demonstrate they have achieved the required knowledge are:

- All applicants currently studying Year 12, including those who have completed or partly completed higher qualifications.
- All applicants whose highest level of study is Year 12.

Course selection officers may deem the required Year 12 knowledge to have been achieved through other qualifications /test results / relevant experience.

All institutions that offer courses through VTAC adhere to this policy. The following information is provided by institutions to further clarify the other ways in which the required Year 12 knowledge may be achieved:

Academy of Interactive Entertainment

Applicants who apply for the Bachelor of Games and Virtual World delivered at AIE Melbourne campus must satisfy Year 12 subject prerequisites – Unit 3 and 4 - a study score of at least 25 in English (any) and a study score of at least 25 in mathematics (any). Exemptions from these prerequisites may be considered, if:

- you have successfully completed the Advanced Diploma of Professional Games Development (Software Development) or the Diploma of Information Technology (Software Development) AND the approved bridging program; OR
- you are of mature age (<http://www.aie.edu.au/StudentInformation/PoliciesProcedures>) can demonstrate an interest in the development of computer games and simulations and are able to demonstrate, at interview, the required level of mathematics and English. This may include the successful completion of an approved bridging program and/or skills assessment in mathematics and English.

Australian Catholic University

To be eligible for selection at Australian Catholic University (ACU), all applicants are required to satisfy the prerequisite subject(s) listed in the course entries. Prerequisites are in place for courses that require a level of knowledge to maximise the chances of success in the course. Subject prerequisites are expressed as achievement in specific Year 12 subjects e.g. Units 3 and 4 – a study score of at least 30 in English (ESL) or 25 in any other English.

ACU may accept alternative results to satisfy prerequisite(s) and the following are some examples:

- Current year 12 applicants who may have marginally failed the prerequisite subject (e.g. has a study score of 24, where 25 was stated) but has scored well in another study considered as a suitable alternative relevant to the course preference;
- Non-year 12 applicants who have successfully completed relevant post-secondary studies, OR relevant work experience; OR who have achieved a sufficiently high Special Tertiary Admissions Test (STAT) result

Australian College of Sports Therapy

The Australian College of Sports Therapy (ACST) adheres to VTAC rules and regulations on prerequisites and entry into ACST courses. The standards of the college in regards to prerequisites are outlined in our Student engagement before enrolment policy see http://www.sportstherapy.edu.au/downloads/student_selection_admission_policy.pdf.

ACST has prescribed entry requirements for each of its courses to ensure that students have appropriate vocational experience, academic and English language skills to undertake the requirements of the course.

Circumstances in which exceptions may be considered include; evidence of life experience, previous employment or education that the admissions committee considers to supersede or represent equivalent learning and/or experience to publish prerequisites. Additionally, ACST interviews all applicants prior to enrolment to ascertain their suitability to the vocation and to successfully engage in studies at ACST.

Australian Maritime College

To be considered eligible for selection to a course you must:

- meet at least one of the general university entry requirements; and
- satisfy course prerequisites and specific entry requirements.

Those who do not possess the required prerequisites can undertake relevant bridging programs and foundation units, free of charge, through the University to meet the required subject prerequisites.

Alternate entry options may be available for applicants who consider they have a case for selection on other grounds; these include, but are not limited to, relevant work experience or completion of a professional or work-based qualification applicable to the course.

Box Hill Institute

VET programs: Most TAFE certificate I to certificate IV courses have no prerequisites. Some diploma/advanced diploma courses will require the completion of pathway courses first, such as a certificate III or IV in the same course area, however this is built into the packaged offer a student receives, and is not a pre-requisite for an offer, as such.

Degree programs: The prerequisites for most Box Hill Institute degree courses is a study score of at least 20 in VCE English (any) Units 3 and 4. In addition some degree courses also require studies in VCE Units 3 and 4 Mathematics, Chemistry or Art. Non-Year 12 applicants may be deemed to have met prerequisite requirements where other qualifications have been completed.

As Box Hill Institute selection criteria and methods take into account the different ways through which the desired characteristics may be demonstrated, and take into consideration the abilities, aptitude, skills, qualifications and the work and life experience of applicants that would indicate their potential to succeed in the program, there may be certain circumstances in which exceptions to the stated prerequisites may be considered, or the prerequisites may be relaxed, as follows.

1. Where an applicant who has not met the stated prerequisites:
 - » is able to demonstrate a high aptitude or skill in the primary course discipline area, and where it is deemed the student would be able to succeed in their chosen program; or
 - » is able to complete bridging or preparatory studies prior to or alongside the qualification to close the skill gap, and maximise the student's potential to succeed in the program; and/or
 - » is a special entry access scheme (SEAS) applicant, and where it is deemed the student would be able to succeed in their chosen program; or
2. where the applicant has completed prior studies/qualifications of an equivalent or higher level to the stated prerequisites, that satisfies the selection officer of prerequisite equivalencies having been achieved.
3. In certain instances the applicant may be required to formalise recognition of their prior study via the Institute's recognition of prior learning processes.

For items 1, 2 and 3 above, the applicant may only be selected:

- where their selection in no way disadvantages other eligible applicants for selection; and
- where the Institute is satisfied that the student is most likely to succeed in their chosen field of study; and
- if the selection officer deems it necessary, the training plan incorporates bridging or preparatory studies to close any identified skill gaps; OR
- if the selection officer deems it necessary, the training plan incorporates appropriate recognition of prior learning to formalise recognition of prerequisite equivalencies, for prior completed qualifications.

Box Hill Institute acknowledges the principles of 'Lifelong Learning', by stating that students who have previously enrolled in a course at Box Hill Institute will be given preferential treatment on application to any aligning and/or corresponding courses. In all instances, course selection criteria will be applied.

Central Queensland University

All VTAC applicants with a preference to a CQUniversity program need to satisfy the program's subject prerequisite or its equivalent to be considered for an offer.

CQUniversity may deem the required subject prerequisites to have been achieved or equivalent through post secondary qualifications, STAT results or work experience. Please contact CQUniversity for further information.

Charles Sturt University

The prerequisites for Education (Early Childhood and Primary) and Education (Middle Schooling) are in place to satisfy the NSW and Victorian Teaching Institutes.

Applicants who do not meet prerequisites but still have a relevant ATAR may be considered for an offer. The course structure for (Early Childhood and Primary) and Education (Middle Schooling) allows for additional study to be completed to meet the requirements of the NSW Institute of Teachers and the Victorian Institute of Teaching.

Chisholm

Applicants are required to satisfy Year 12 subject prerequisites.

Mature age applicants without the required prerequisite qualifications may be considered where they can demonstrate significant industry experience that shows an appropriate level of knowledge, commitment and academic capacity to cope with the subject content.

Applicants who have not recently studied at an appropriate level may be required to undergo an evaluation of their English and mathematics skills.

Deakin University

The University will set the minimum eligibility criteria for admission to undergraduate courses, which will be as follows:

- Applicants who apply for courses other than Associate Degrees, on the basis of a Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) Year 12 or equivalent secondary qualification must have a VCE ATAR of at least 50, or notional equivalent score, or an equivalent score in an equivalent qualification, and a study score of at least 20 in English, English Language or Literature units 3 and 4, or a study score of at least 25 in VCE English as a Second Language; or documentary evidence of English-language proficiency as specified in [Schedule A](#).
- Applicants who have completed or partially completed either a higher education course at an approved university, or a Vocational Education and Training (VET) or Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning (VCAL) qualification must be able to demonstrate educational experience at least equivalent to the eligibility criteria for applicants completing a VCE Year 12 or equivalent final secondary qualification.
Exception:
Applicants may apply under the Deakin Access and Equity Program where they:
 - » have suffered educational or other disadvantage which has adversely affected their preparation for university study
 - » are able to demonstrate a potential to succeed at higher education study
 - » meet the eligibility criteria

Goulburn Ovens Institute of TAFE

Students wishing to undertake the **Diploma of Agriculture** will have completed:

- A Certificate IV in Agriculture or equivalent; OR
- Are able to demonstrate they have experience in Agriculture which includes some supervisory experience or on farm production experience; OR
- Have successfully completed year 12 and have successfully completed an Agriculture school based traineeship or a VETIS Agriculture program.

Students wishing to commence the **Advanced Diploma of Agriculture** program will have completed:

- A Diploma of Agriculture or equivalent; OR
- Are able to demonstrate significant experience in the area of Agriculture which includes supervisory experience on farm production experience and management concepts; OR
- Have successfully completed year 12 and have successfully completed an Agriculture school based traineeship or a VETIS Agriculture program and experience in the area of Agriculture which includes supervisory experience on farm production experience and management concepts.

Holmesglen

Bachelor of Early Childhood Education and Bachelor of Nursing: The selection and admission policy supports selection of year 12 applicants who are capable of succeeding in their chosen program. To this end:

- 1.1. Admission prerequisites are designed and monitored to support selection of applicants who are capable of succeeding in the Bachelor of Early Childhood Education or Bachelor of Nursing programs, on the basis of merit and/or to meet professional accreditation conditions.
- 1.2. Consideration of SEAS applicants will be applied.
- 1.3. Selection decisions are fair, consistent, as objective as possible, and transparent. As such, there are no circumstances in which exceptions may be considered in lieu of prerequisites.
- 1.4. Applicants who provide false information or incomplete information during the application process may have their offer cancelled without notice.

La Trobe Melbourne

Prerequisites published in the VTAC Guide must be satisfied before an offer can be made except where:

- The required knowledge has been achieved through successful completion of a bridging or preparatory course in the relevant field. OR
- Alternate qualifications such as a Certificate IV in a relevant discipline.

La Trobe University

Applicants for admission to courses at La Trobe University must meet the general entry requirements prescribed by the University's Admissions Policy and Procedures, including any course prerequisites established for entry to a particular course. Students who apply on the basis of current VCE studies are required to meet the VCE prerequisites. However, provision is made for students applying on the basis of other educational backgrounds to demonstrate, to the satisfaction of the University, that they have attained an equivalent level of knowledge and skill through means other than the completion of the prerequisite studies. These means may include:

- successful application through a Special Entry and Access Scheme (SEAS);
- successful completion of a relevant bridging, enabling or preparatory program;
- an appropriate level of attainment in a relevant admissions test;
- completion, at the appropriate level, of an alternative Year 12, interstate or overseas programs recognised by the University as equivalent to the Victorian VCE;
- successful tertiary study in a relevant area;
- relevant work experience.

Melbourne Institute of Business and Technology

All Courses: Consideration will be given for students who do not meet the English prerequisite by sitting the MIBT English Diagnostic Tool.

Engineering: Consideration will be given to applicants who have not met the Mathematics prerequisites if they are prepared to enrol in additional mathematics units in conjunction with the Diploma.

Melbourne Institute of Technology

Applicants will be required to satisfy Year 12 subject prerequisites or demonstrate equivalence.

In some circumstances, applicants may be admitted into the course if the applicant is able to demonstrate a range of attributes such as personal motivation, maturity, work experience or previous study. This is assessed on a case by case basis and is subject to approval by relevant School. Applicants may be required to attend an interview in person, on campus.

Monash College

All applicants admitted to Monash College must meet the minimum entrance requirements, as approved by the Monash College Academic Board in consultation with Monash University. The Monash College Academic Board may grant an exemption to the entrance requirements under the following circumstances:

- Where applicant has applied under the VTAC Special Entry Access Scheme. For applicants with an ATAR, special admission consideration will take the form of a notional bonus of points added to their aggregate score, which will result in a higher ranking for selection.
- Where applicant's post-secondary study or other learning experiences have been assessed as equivalent to an Australian Year 12 by the Board.

Monash University

Entrance requirements for all Monash University courses are governed by Statute.

All applicants admitted to Monash University must meet the University's minimum entrance requirements, as approved by Academic Board. In exceptional circumstances Academic Board may grant an exemption. All applicants admitted to a course must meet the published course VCE prerequisites or equivalent.

Consistent with the Australian Qualifications Framework, equivalence of content and learning outcomes may be demonstrated by:

- Successful completion of interstate Year 12 subjects specified as equivalent by ACTAC at the required level performance, OR
- Post secondary study, work experience or other learning experiences assessed as equivalent by the course managing faculty.

Navitas College of Public Safety

To be eligible for selection at Navitas College of Public Safety (NCPS), prerequisites published in the VTAC Guide must be satisfied before an offer can be made except where:

- A current year 12 applicant has marginally failed the prerequisite subject but has scored well in another subject relevant to the course (e.g. Legal Studies, Psychology);
- A non-year 12 applicant has successfully completed relevant post-secondary studies, or relevant work experience OR has achieved a sufficiently high Special Tertiary Admissions Test (STAT) result;
- An applicant has applied for and been granted SEAS.

Northern Melbourne Institute of TAFE

VTAC applicants who do not meet the required prerequisite studies, are required to fill out the VTAC Personal History online.

In addition, these applicants must bring evidence to their interview of any relevant employment, qualifications or other relevant documentation to demonstrate their ability to undertake study at the required level. Alternatively, where applicable, applicants will be given the opportunity to audition or present a folio as part of the selection process.

Non Year 12 applicants applying for the Bachelors of Education (Early Years), Early Years Studies or the Associate Degree in Early Years Studies who have not completed Year 12 (or equivalent) must sit the Special Tertiary Admissions Test, Multiple Choice (STAT). For additional information and advice on eligibility to sit the STAT, please call (03) 9269 1390.

Students who have submitted a Special Entry Access Scheme (SEAS) application and may be one or two points short of the required study score will have all aspects of their course application taken into account by Selection Officers.

Prior to the commencement of the academic year for the Primary Industries courses, bridging programs are offered to applicants who have not studied one of the listed subjects at the required level, and the subject is a prerequisite. Subjects offered are Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics which are a required prerequisite for the Bachelor of Agriculture and Land Management, the Bachelor of Aquaculture and Environmental Management, the Bachelor of Equine Studies, and the Bachelor of Viticulture and Winemaking. Successfully completing a bridging program will enable students to attain the required level of knowledge for entry into a Primary Industries degree program at NMIT.

RMIT University

Applicants in the following groups who have not completed the stated VCE prerequisite may satisfy the prerequisite by demonstrating, to the satisfaction of RMIT, that they have achieved an equivalent level of skills and knowledge:

- Applicants whose highest qualification is year 12 but who completed year 12 more than two years prior to the date of application to RMIT
- Applicants who have completed additional qualifications following year 12;
- Applicants who have completed overseas year 12; and
- Applicants who have completed non-standard year 12.

An equivalent level of skills and knowledge may be demonstrated through tertiary study, test results, overseas year 12 study and/or work experience.

The onus is on applicants to demonstrate that they satisfy prerequisites. Applicants must provide supporting evidence, and set out any relevant supporting information in the VTAC Personal History form.

Southern School of Natural Therapies

All applicants to the Southern School of Natural Therapies are required to undertake an admission interview prior to successful offer. The purpose of the admissions interview is to assess the applicant's suitability and commitment to the course. The interview also gives prospective students an opportunity to clarify details about their course and their enrolment. Please see individual course listings for any additional prerequisites. Applicants who do not meet stated individual course prerequisite requirements may still be considered for selection where the Careers and Course advisor deems that the applicant has demonstrated a commitment to study and passion for the course content based on demonstrated knowledge or work experience and the outcome of their admissions interview.

South West TAFE

Applicants who are required to satisfy Year 12 subject prerequisites or demonstrate they have achieved the required knowledge are:

- All applicants currently studying Year 12, including those who have completed or partly completed higher qualifications.
- All applicants whose highest level of study is Year 12.

Course selection officers may deem the required Year 12 knowledge to have been achieved through other qualifications, test results or relevant experience.

Sunraysia Institute of TAFE

Applicants who do not meet stated prerequisite requirements may still be considered for selection where Course selection officers deem that the required knowledge has been achieved through other qualifications, test results or relevant experience.

Swinburne University of Technology

The admission of a student at Swinburne is based on entry requirements approved by the University's Academic Senate. Minimum entry requirements and selection criteria for award programs are specified in individual program accreditation documentation.

To be eligible for consideration for standard entry, applicants must have satisfactorily completed the Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) or its equivalent, such as an interstate or international Year 12 qualification, with any specified prerequisite studies and any other specific requirements as published under Prerequisites and Extra requirements in individual program entries in the VTAC Guide or in Swinburne's online course information.

Where applicants do not meet the tertiary entrance requirements for their selected program, including prerequisites, applicants may be selected for program entry in exceptional circumstances such as:

- the required knowledge has otherwise been achieved through other qualifications or other relevant experience, as determined by Swinburne's selection and admissions officers and following the requirements of the Admission to Coursework Programs Policy and Procedure
- the applicant applied under special consideration such as Special Entry Access Scheme (SEAS).

University of Ballarat

Applicants who are required to satisfy Year 12 subject prerequisites or demonstrate they have achieved the required knowledge are:

- All applicants currently studying Year 12, including those who have completed or partly completed higher qualifications.
- All applicants whose highest level of study is Year 12.

Course selection officers may deem the required Year 12 knowledge to have been achieved through other qualifications, test results or relevant experience.

University of Melbourne (The)

Applicants who are required to satisfy Year 12 subject prerequisites or demonstrate that they have attained an equivalent prerequisite are:

- All applicants currently studying Year 12, including those who have completed or partly completed higher qualifications.
- All applicants whose highest level of study is Year 12, including applicants eligible under the University's Non-school leaver entry pathway.

Victoria University

At Victoria University, we recognise that a diverse range of previous learning experiences can provide you with knowledge which may indicate a reasonable likelihood of success in your studies with us. As a consequence, applicants who do not meet the stated prerequisite requirements may still be considered for selection where Course selection officers deem that the required knowledge has been achieved as a result of completion of other year 12 subjects, previous qualifications, test results, and relevant life and or work experience.
