## VCE Results and the ENTER

VCE results and the ENTER will be available on the Results 2000 service from 12noon on Monday 11 December. A copy of your VCE results and ENTER will be sent to students on Monday 11 December 2000. While all students enrolled in a Year 12 subject will be able to access their VCE results, only those meeting tertiary entrance requirement will receive an ENTER.

## Results 2000 Service

To assist Year 12 VCE students access their results and ENTER the Board of Studies and VTAC will run a joint telephone and Internet service called Results 2000.

Results 2000 will provide those VCE students with at least one Year 12 study and those who have qualified for an ENTER, with a one stop shop of results.

Results 2000 will operate 24 hours a day from 12noon on Monday 11 December to Tuesday 19 December.

## Results 2000 Telephone Service

- ▶ To access the telephone service you will need your VCE student number and PIN (that has already been issued to you by VTAC)
- ▶ If you have not received a PIN from VTAC, you must use the PIN sent to your school by the Board of Studies.
- ▶ Telephone 1900 957 888 (\$1.65 per minute inc. GST, higher from mobile or public telephones)

## Results 2000 Internet Service

- ▶ To access your ENTER you will need your VCE student number and PIN.
- ▶ If you have not received a PIN from VTAC, you must use the PIN sent to your school by the Board of Studies
- ▶ To access your VCE results from the Board of Studies you will also need an Internet Access Code in addition to your VCE student number and PIN.

## Internet Access Code

You do not need an Internet Access code to access the ENTER. To obtain an Internet Access Code you must call the Board of Studies Internet Registration on 1902 267 003. The charge for this call is \$5.50 (inc. GST). The call cannot be made from a payphone or some mobile phones.

## Free Post Results Enquiry Service (PRES)

VTAC and the Board of Studies are providing a joint information service to answer any enquiries you may have once you have received your VCE results and ENTER. This service will not provide you with your results or ENTER.

The PRES will operate from 12noon Monday 11 December until 8pm, then from 9am to 5pm Tuesday 12, Thursday 14 December. The telephone number for the PRES will be in the September and October editions of the Board of Studies VCE Bulletin and the October edition of the VTAC Bulletin. Details will also be published on both the VTAC and Board websites. Copies of the Bulletins will be sent to all schools.

If for any reason, you do not receive your documentation from VTAC or the Board of Studies—don't panic, it may be held up in the mail.
