## VCE eligibility rules and the ENTER

The VCAA are changing the VCE eligibility rules as of 2005. Reference: Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority, Memorandum to schools: 58/2004. These changes do not affect VTAC policy on minimum entry requirements for tertiary entrance.

In order to be eligible for tertiary entrance:

- > you must have obtained your VCE
- > you must have satisfactorily completed Units 3 & 4 in the same year of the compulsory English study by completing one of English, English as a Second Language (ESL), Literature or English Language.

The principles that VTAC has in place on subject use in the ENTER calculation remains the same.

### Restrictions on subject use in the calculation of an ENTER

Only one study from the range of studies listed on page 5 of both the VICTER 2006 and VICTER 2007 can be used in the calculation of the ENTER. (That is the best six studies.)

### Restrictions on subject use in the primary four

On page 6 of both VICTER 2006 and VICTER 2007 there is a list of study combinations for which only one can be used in the calculation of the "primary four" (the other may be used as an increment).

### VET in Schools program

A maximum of two sequences of Units 3 & 4 (awarded a VCAA study score) of a VET program may be counted in the "primary four".

At most three VCE VET Unit 3 & 4 sequences can contribute to the ENTER.

### Update on Common Entry Standard for clusters of courses

The University of Melbourne wishes to clarify information published in the VTAC Guide 2005:

To enable prospective Australian students to maximize options with their preferences expressed through VTAC, the University of Melbourne has clustered a range of courses together according to the same academic standard required for entry.

If a prospective Australian student wishes to be considered for entry to any of the courses in a cluster, they should decide which is their most preferred course in the cluster and (provided course prerequisites are met) should include a preference for this course only. Both a Commonwealth Supported Place (CSP) and an Australian fee preference can be indicated. The ENTER or equivalent required to receive an offer will be identical for each course in the cluster. No other courses from that cluster can be listed in the preferences.

VTAC has modified their application process to enable an applicant to enter only one course in each cluster, in each fee type.

# Amendments

The course clusters are listed below.

Applicants should ensure that they indicate a preference for the course they most wish to undertake from a cluster. Applicants will be considered for this course only and not for any other course in that cluster.

This consistent approach to admission to single and combined courses will enable applicants to gain maximum use of their VTAC preferences.
