## Parent sessions 2005

Over the last few years VTAC has been invited to speak at a wide range of parent sessions during the application period of late July through August.

The disparity in attendance at many of the metropolitan sessions balanced with VTAC's resources has led to a rethink about how VTAC could best support schools with this program. As a result, we propose the following process for 2005:

- VTAC will invite all interested Careers Teachers to a training seminar in Term 2. The aim of this seminar will be to brief Careers Teachers on the burning VTAC issues and supply written material and a PowerPoint presentation for teachers to use in their presentation.

**Please note:** VTAC is in the process of identifying three or four metropolitan parent sessions whereby attendance has been consistently above 250. Where possible, and if invited, VTAC staff will continue to participate in these sessions.

- Based on criteria to be circulated in January, VTAC will be available to participate in regional parent sessions coordinated through the local regional careers group. It is hoped that these sessions will be conducted simultaneously with the regional briefing sessions.
