ENTERs will be available via VTAC CourseLink to schools from 4pm on Sunday 11 December and to students at 7am on Monday 12 December. ENTER subject scores will not be available until 10am Monday 12 December. When accessing CourseLink, schools and their staff are reminded about the requirements associate with the VTAC privacy policy.

Forgotten your CourseLink name/password?

To ensure the information is reissued to you prior to Sunday 11 December, your school must submit the appropriate form, available from Teacher Access on VTAC CourseLink by no later than 5pm Thursday 8 December 2005. Requests submitted after that time cannot be guaranteed prior to Sunday 11 December.

Downloading of data

When your school receives the ENTERs they will be recorded in Rank order. VTAC recommends that your school download or save the data file of students, as this information will not be available between 7am and 10am on Monday 13 December.

Post Results Enquiry Service (PRES)

To assist you in accessing your VCE results, ENTER subject scores and ENTER, the VCAA and VTAC will run a joint service called, The 2005 VCE Results and ENTER Service.

To access your results on this service you will need your VCAA student number and PIN. If you are a VTAC applicant use your VTAC PIN. If you are not a VTAC applicant use the first four digits of your birth date (e.g. 22 June = 2206).

This service offers three options for accessing your VCE results and ENTER:

The Internet – results.vcaa.vic.edu.au

Your results will be available on the internet from 7am Monday 12 December to 12noon on Monday 19 December 2005 (AEDST).

The internet service is free and will operate 24 hours per day. Log onto results.vcaa.vic.edu.au using your VCAA student number and PIN.

SMS – 19 787 888

VCE results and ENTER are sent by SMS from 7am on Monday 12 December 2005.

To receive an SMS notification you must pre-register between:

9am Monday 14 November – 12midnight Sunday 11 December 2005 by sending your VCAA student number and PIN to 19 787 888 (Legion Interactive cost \$1.10 max inc. GST) in the following format:

SSSSSSSS PPPP

VCE results and ENTER statements will be posted to applicants and are due for arrival from Tuesday 13 December 2005.

If you have any questions once you have received your ENTER and VCE results you may contact the Post Results Enquiry Service (PRES). PRES is a joint information service offered by VTAC and VCAA for any questions you have, not for accessing your VCE results or ENTER.

The PRES will operate from:

Choose *File > Print*

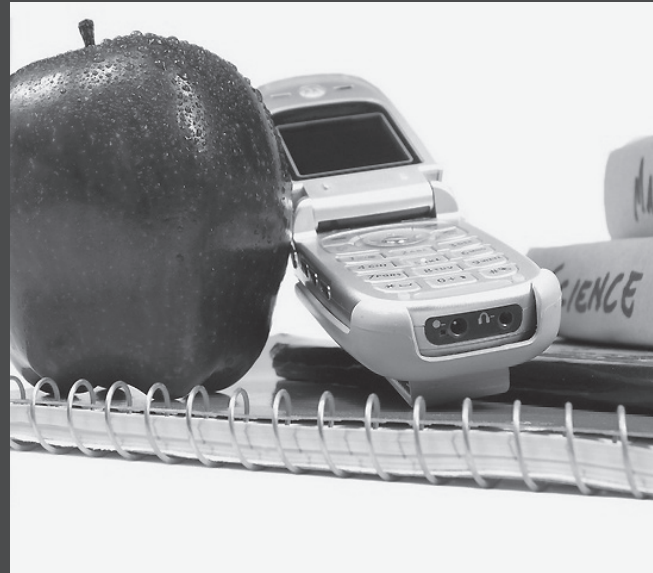
