Lost Passwords

In order to be reissued with your school's password and/or login, schools must undertake the following procedures:

- ▶ Write or fax your request on school letterhead to David Osborne, Manager Schools Liaison, on fax (03) 9686 6054
- ▶ State your name, position and request. There will be a maximum of 48-hour turnaround on lost passwords.
- ▶ Should you require your password earlier, an \$11.00 fee will be charged and invoiced at a later date. This request must be included in your fax/letter.
- ▶ Include name and signature of principal.
- ▶ Passwords and/or login names will not be issued over the telephone.

Access Now!

Both students and staff from schools have taken to CourseLink with enthusiasm. Feedback on the usefulness of the program has been most favourable. To date there have been 32, 450 'hits' to the service; 28, 927 users have accessed the 'Student Access' and 418 Schools have logged on to 'Teacher Access'.

Teachers Remember: to receive your daily update of your school's students who have **not** applied through VTAC, log into the VTAC CourseLink 'Teacher Access' and *click* onto 'Student Reports'. From here you just *click* onto the 'Students with no preferences' indicator.
