Update to institutional contact with applicants

Whenever a year 12 student or adult applies for a tertiary course through VTAC, their applicant information is sent onto the institution to assist the institution with eligibility for SEAS, Scholarships and advice on new and cancelled courses.

More recently, the VTAC Management Committee amended the rules to allow institutions to use these lists for other limited purposes including:

- The clarification of application details that cannot otherwise be obtained from VTAC
- Reminders about dates and deadlines for extra requirements, as published with VTAC
- To advise changes to the availability of the course, campus, major study, or title and length as published in the VTAC Bulletin

- To provide information about institutional services and opportunities, for example accommodation, financial assistance and scholarships, career advice, childcare
- To advise of open days and information sessions
- To provide additional information about courses (eg course brochures), alternative entry pathways, institutional partnership arrangements

If an individual does not wish to be advised of any of these matters, they should contact the privacy officer at the institution directly.

Student Services and Amenities Fee

In October 2011, the Australian Parliament passed the Higher Education Legislation Amendment (Student Services and Amenities) Bill 2011. This legislation allows universities and other higher education providers to charge a compulsory Student Services and Amenities Fee (SSAF) from 1 January 2012.

The fee may be used by higher education providers for student services and may include items such as counselling, employment/career advice, child care, financial advice, food services and sporting and recreational activities, as well as independent student representation structures.

For further information, the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations (DEEWR) website provides details on the Bill. This website also includes the draft representative and administrative guidelines.

Australian citizens and permanent humanitarian visa holders are eligible to defer the fee through a new element of the Higher Education Loan Program (HELP) known as SA-HELP. For further information on eligibility requirements, please see the SA-HELP FAQ
