

## 2008 ENTER and results service

### What is the ENTER?

The Equivalent National Tertiary Entrance Rank (ENTER) is an overall measure of how well a VCE student has performed in their VCE studies. It is created by the Victorian Tertiary Admissions Centre (VTAC) on behalf of institutions to assist in tertiary selection.

### Who will get an ENTER?

All students who have satisfied the requirements for the VCE and have study scores for one of (English, ESL, English Language or Literature) and at least three other studies (in a permissible combination) will be eligible to receive an ENTER.

### Who will get an ENTER statement?

An ENTER statement will be issued to applicants who have paid all processing fees, have been awarded the VCE for the first time and have a minimum of four VCAA study scores (including a score for an English study) which are not subject to any restrictions or forbidden combinations.

Students who have not paid processing fees will not receive an ENTER statement.

Students who have previously obtained an ENTER, but have undertaken further study this year, resulting in an additional study score or increment(s) will have their ENTER recalculated. The higher of the two ENTERs will be recorded and reported.

### Accessing your ENTER

VCE students have three options for accessing their ENTER:

- log onto the Internet at [results.vcaa.vic.edu.au](http://results.vcaa.vic.edu.au)
- telephone the Results Infoline on 1900 957 888 at \$1.93 (higher for mobile phones)
- submit an SMS request to 19 787 888 (call cost \$1.10 per registration)

To access their ENTER students will also need their VCE student number and VTAC PIN.

### Lost PINs

Check the mail, VTAC has posted all Year 12 VCE students a reminder letter containing their VCAA/VTAC student number and PIN.

Still can't find it? Click on the 'lost PIN' link on the front page of the website and follow the prompts.

## Prerequisites clarification: Education courses

Following discussion between VTAC and the Victorian Institute of Teaching (VIT) the VIT has granted an exemption to the new prerequisite requirements for mathematics introduced for 2009.
