

# About selection data

## Selection Data

Selection data is produced for Type 1 courses, offered at universities and RMIT TAFE that use the ENTER as a significant criterion for course selection. The following groups of applicants are included in the calculation of this data:

- » 2008 year 12 students studying the VCE (or interstate equivalent) who were eligible for and received an ENTER (or equivalent)
- » 2008 students studying the IB in Victoria who were eligible for and received a Notional ENTER

Selection Data does not measure or include the selection standards for adult applicants and applicants with previous Year 12 or tertiary results.

It is calculated for the sole purpose of providing VCE (or interstate equivalent) students and IB students studying in Victoria, with an indication of last years selection standards and corresponding ENTERs (or current equivalent) required for courses. The data is last year's data and should be used as a guide only.

**Main Round Data, 20 January 2009:** Presents the selection standard of the main round of offers for tertiary places as of the 20 January 2009.

**Final Round Data - 17 February 2009:** Presents figures after all rounds of offers for tertiary places as of the 17 February 2009.

### Total number of offers:

Is broken down into two groups:

- » **2008 Year 12 students:** shows the number of offers made to 2008 Year 12 students for tertiary places in 2009.
- » **All applicants (including adults):** shows the total number of offers made to all applicants (2008 Year 12 students and all other applicant groups including adults) for tertiary places in 2009.

**The Clearly-in ENTER** is the rank at or above which all ranked (eligible) applicants who applied for that course were offered a place.

In this example everyone who was eligible for, and applied for this course with an ENTER at or above 64.50 at the completion of Main round offers (20 January 2009) would have received an offer

The Clearly-in ENTER is determined by three factors:

- » the number of places available in the course; and
- » the number of applicants listing the course as a preference; and
- » the academic achievement of those applicants.

Clearly-in ENTERs are not set in advance and as a result are different to Guaranteed ENTERs and may vary from year to year.

### Fringe ENTER: the rank, at or above which the majority (95%) of offers were made.

Not everyone above the Fringe ENTER will be made an offer. This figure simply represents the ENTER where 95% of offers were made. This means that for Nursing, 95% of offers were made to students with an ENTER at or above 63.35 and for Graphic Design 95% of offers went to students with an ENTER at or above 83.95. Not everyone with an ENTER at or above 63.35 or 83.95 will have automatically received an offer.

### % of offers below the Clearly-in ENTER: shows the percentage of offers made to applicants with an ENTER lower than the Clearly in ENTER.

In the Nursing example for Main round offers, 12.00% of offers were made to applicants with an ENTER lower than the clearly in ENTER of 64.50.

**RC**— indicates that offers are made to applicants based on a range of criteria, such as folio, interview, test etc. This information is outlined in 'Selection mode' statements in individual course entries.

**Fringe ENTER**— In instances where a range of criteria is used in conjunction with the ENTER, institutions will publish the ENTER at which 95% of offers were made. This means that not everyone with an ENTER at or above 86.72 will automatically received an offer.

**The total number of offers** made is useful to both current year 12 students and adult applicants.

The 2008 Year 12 students tells you how many students were offered a place. The total includes offers made to all groups (including adults).
