

## Section J

### Undergraduate Supplementary Offers

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This is the first year that VTAC has published statistics on Supplementary Offers. Supplementary offers can only be made to applicants who have not received an offer in Early, First or Second round. An institution can make a supplementary offer to an applicant regardless of whether the course was listed in the applicant's preferences or not. For this reason, they should not be interpreted as a measure of demand by applicants.
