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A 1: Analysis of UG Applications, Offers, Enrolments and Deferments by Region

Applications: the number of people who applied, paid in full on time, and listed in their preferences at least one undergraduate course.

Applicants Offered: the subset of people in 'Applications' who received at least one non-supplementary offer, for an undergraduate course listed in their preferences, excluding those with no matching record in the 31 March student census.

Enrolments as of 31 March: the number of people in 'Applicants Offered' who were listed as enrolled full or part time on 31 March, in an undergraduate course offered to them. This excludes those enrolled in courses via supplementary offers.

Deferments: the number of people in 'Applicants Offered' who were listed as deferred before 31 March, an undergraduate course offered to them. This excludes those who deferred courses from supplementary offers.

For each applicant, their region was based on their residential postcode. Within Victoria, the regions used were Statistical Local Area 4, of the Australian Statistical Geography Standard, of the Australian Bureau of Statistics. Outside of Victoria, the regions used were State. The regions used in this VTAC Annual Statistics are different to those used in past VTAC Annual Statistics.

The conversion table from postcode to SLA4 was taken from ABS catalogue number 1270.0.55.006, released in July 2012. Where a single postcode mapped to multiple SLA4 regions, the region with the higher residential population was allocated.
